

## **Ballet Tic Tac Toe**

To prepare, you will need a set of index cards and a marker. Use the cards to make one set of 9 cards for each student or team, with one of the following words written on each card: jump, hop, leap, saute (means jump), temps levé,( a small hop on one foot, with the other foot raised off the floor. jeté, (jumping on one foot at a time), 2 feet, 1 foot, 1 foot to the other.

Introduce the students to the pedestrian actions of jumping (taking off and landing on 2 feet), hoping (taking off and landing on 1 foot), and leaping (taking off on one foot and landing on the other). Have the students practice jumping, hopping, and leaping by playing a movement game like Freeze Dance or Follow the Leader with these actions.

Next, introduce the ballet steps saute, temps levé, and jeté – a stylized jump, hop, and leap, respectively. You can begin with traditional ballet drills, and then use a movement game like Freeze Dance or Follow the Leader to reinforce students, understanding of these actions.

Finally, students are ready for the game – a great way to review what was learned! Place the 9 index cards in a pile on the floor, face down. The winner will be the first student or team to organize their set cards, with jump, saute, and 2 feet in one row, hop, temps levé, and 1 foot in the next, and leap, jeté, and one foot to the other in the third.
